




1250 to	The Trojan war began in the city of Troy between the		
1240 BC	Trojans and Greeks. It lasted ten years. The Greeks used a		
	wooden horse as a trick, they hid inside it to enter Troy and		
	defeated the Trojans.		
776 BC	The first modern Olympic games were held in Greece.		
431 to	Armies from areas of Greece called Athens and Sparta		
404 BC	fought against each other in the Peloponnesian War over		
	land. Greece was then invaded by foreign armies from		
	Persia so the Athens and Sparta armies joined together to		
	defend Greece from the Persians.		
336 BC	Alexander the Great became king of Macedonia.		
146 BC	Ancient Greece became part of the Roman Empire when		
	they invaded.		

Alexander the Great —was a powerful ruler and at one time controlled all of Greece. He became king of the Ancient Greek kingdom of Macedonia in 336BC at the age of 20 and created one of the largest empires in history. He was undefeated in battle and was considered as one of the greatest rulers in Ancient Greek history.
